WHEREAS, the Gallatin County Commissioners previously established fees for the Gallatin County Court Services Program in its Resolution 2011-062 and as amended in 2013-093 and the fees are in need of amendment;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-5-2101, MCA the Gallatin County Commissioners have the authority to manage the business and concerns of the county in all cases where no other provision is made by law;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-5-2133, MCA the County may charge a fee to recover the costs of providing electronic government services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §46-23-1005 Gallatin County has established a misdemeanor probation office as part of the Gallatin County Court Service Program;

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-6-4013, MCA allows the County to charge fees that are reasonable and related to the cost of providing the service;

WHEREAS, fees for the Gallatin County Court Services Program were determined to be are reasonable and related to the cost of providing the service in Resolution 2011-067;

WHEREAS, additional fees and changes in fees set forth in this Resolution are justified as reasonable and related to the cost of providing service as follows: 1) The fees have not been updated since 2013; 2) the minimal increase in fees assists to offsets the increase in expenditures; 3) the replacement value of equipment is consistent with current pricing; 4) fees for programs no longer offered (MSPOA Grant program, Money Management) are not included in the current resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: All of the fees set forth in Gallatin County Resolution 2013-093 are amended as follows for the Gallatin County Court Services Program:
