How to submit for CEASE Award Reimbursement:

- 1) For Overtime Patrols, the information requested on the reporting form included in the application must be included with your Request for Reimbursement, whether you use the form itself or use the type of reporting forms expected for STEP patrols. Do not bill for Per Diem.
- 2) Include a cover sheet clarifying who the reimbursement check should be made out to, along with the mailing address. Include documentation of expenses.
- 3) Also include documentation of a Press Release, including when and where it ran. Awardees will be expected to report back to the CEASE Committee on the outcome of the project.
