Keep an eye out for yellow starthistle!

Yellow starthistle is not known to occur in Montana, but it has the potential to cause massive ecological and economic damage. It is vitally important that we prevent it from establishing in Montana!



Flowers:

Bright yellow
One flower per stem
Look similar to knapweed

Spines:

Straw colored

Very sharp—Be careful!

Up to 1 inch long

Stems:

Very rigid
Grow 1 to 5 feet tall

Stem Leaves:

Covered with fine white hairs

Flat extensions make the stem

appear "winged"

Basal Leaves:

Deeply lobed Pointed tips
